Please be assured that efforts are undertaken at The Clay Room to reduce the presence of clay dust, such as wet mopping and wiping down affected hard surfaces and floors.

Involvement in these classes constitutes an acknowledgment by the sponsoring party (ies) that they are aware of some inherent risk in these classes and agree to hold The Clay Room harmless, without condition or limitation, in the event of any injury or harm to themselves or the student. The Clay Room is not responsible for damage or loss of personal property; we strongly recommend you leave your valuables and jewelry at home while taking a class. Due to our limited space, we can not store your personal belongings after class, so please take them with you when you leave.
